NEW Logo

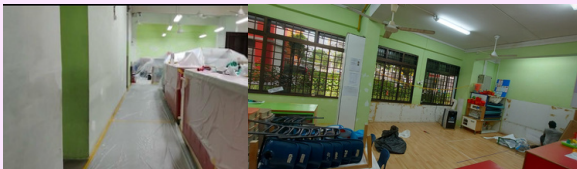

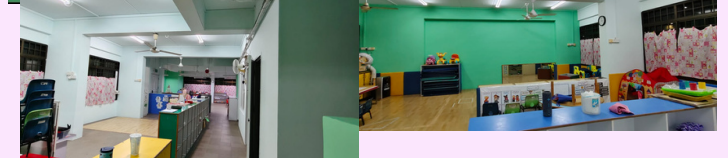
